Individual Categories

Community Engagement award

An individual who is committed to building relationships in an innovative and practical way within the community they support, ensuring positive outcomes for children, young people and families.

Partnership School of the Year

Recognition for a school that hears and responds to the voice of the child, supports the whole family and exceed the expectations of an educational setting, in areas such as protective behaviours, emotional wellbeing, 1:1 pupil work, etc.

□ Key worker of the Year

An outstanding key worker who shows exceptional commitment and determination and goes above and beyond what is expected of them in their day to day role.

Early Years Worker of the Year

An outstanding worker within early years who shows exceptional commitment and determination and goes above and beyond what is expected of them in their day to day role.

Admin Support Worker of the Year

Behind every great team is a great administrative support worker! Do you know someone who constantly goes above and beyond to support your team and the families you work with?

Manager/Team Leader of the Year

An exceptional team manager/ leader who has consistently had a positive impact on, not only their service but also the team members within in it.

Unsung Hero Award

An award to acknowledge those in the wider community who's good work is invaluable, yet not always obviously recognised. This could be a worker within a social/sports club, food bank, or an unpaid volunteer who has shown selfless kindness during the pandemic. Someone who has placed others ahead of themselves, offering care and support to their community in it's time of need. (Not all super-heroes wear capes!)

Group Categories

□ Innovative Early Intervention (programme or initiative)

An award to celebrate the success of an innovative early intervention programme/initiative and the **people** behind its delivery.

\square Services to young people team of the year

A team who work tirelessly to improve the lives of young people by providing an outstanding service that ensures the best outcomes for young people.

□ Services to Families team of the year.

A team who work with families in Hertfordshire, bringing positive change to the whole family through outstanding work and commitment.

Addressing Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) through practice

For a team or individual who is leading on the adaptation of practices to take into account the impact of Adverse Childhood Experiences on the families they work with. Ensuring the prevention of intergenerational issues.

Collaborative Team of the Year

A team who is committed to building relationships and/or joint working with colleagues across different services/agencies to ensure positive outcomes.

□ Team of the year

A team (frontline or otherwise) which consistently goes above and beyond, are resilient, passionate, and are exceptionally dedicated to their work.
