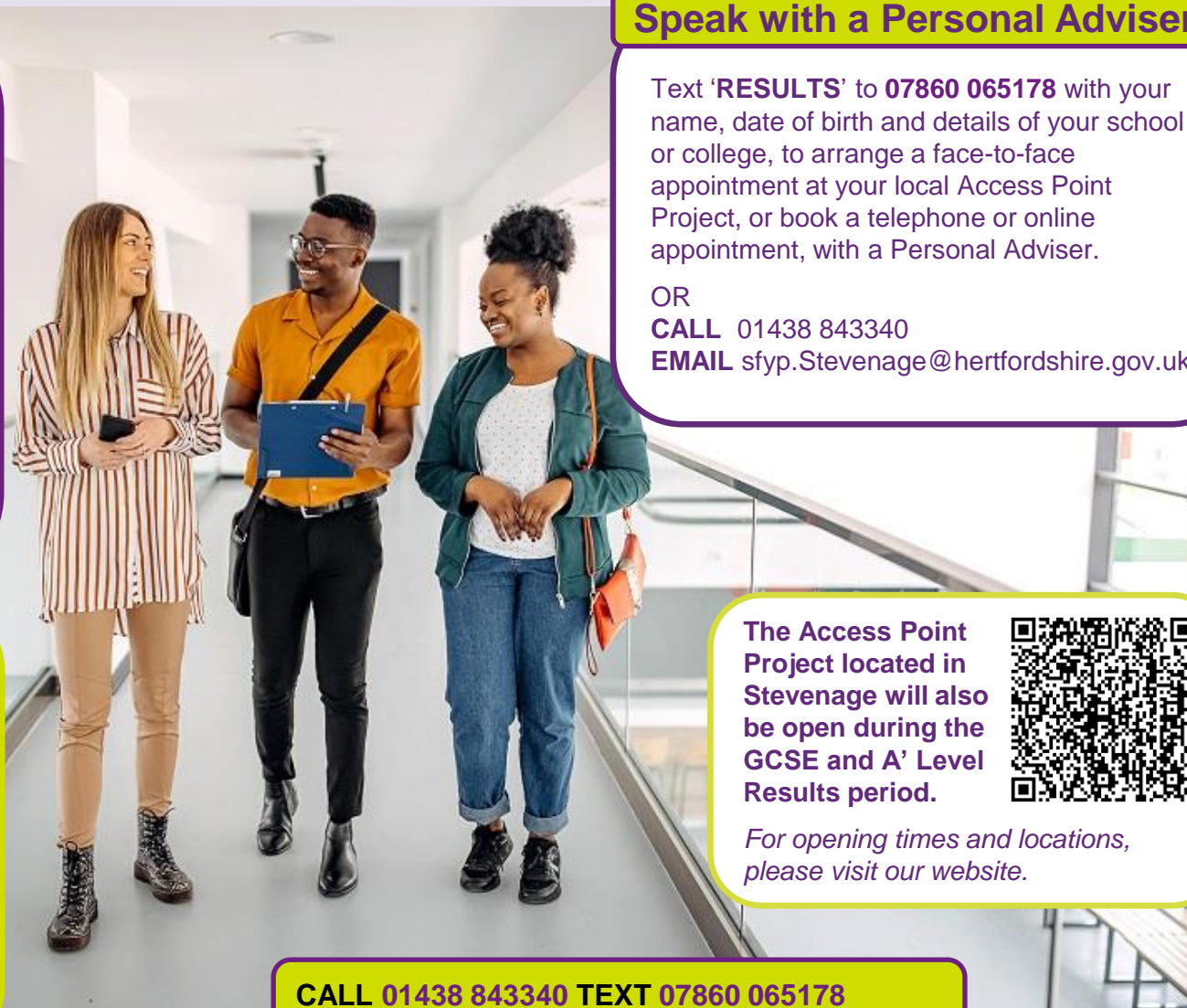
Really think hard about what you would like to do and research! This will give you the best chance of making the right choice for you.
