Courses

Courses are for all Hertfordshire residents and include:

Parenting When Separated: 6 week group based course for separated parents that focuses on the emotional impact of separation and supporting communication between co-parents

Face to Face course to be held in Stevenage (venue tbc) starting on Thursday 17th October until the 28th November (excluding 31st October for half term) 10-12:30
